EXTRACT FROM THE RULES AND REGULATIONS

10. COUNCIL OF THE INSTITUTE

- ii) a) The Council shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Honorary Secretary, Honorary Joint Secretary, Honorary Treasurer and twelve elected members.
- ii) b) The Council shall also consist of all Past-Presidents and the immediate Past Secretary as ex-officio members.

Chairman of (i) Examination and (ii) Membership

Committees shall be permanent invitees to the Council.

12. ELECTION OF THE COUNCIL

The mode of election of the members of the Council to assume office in the year 1976 and thereafter in the appropriate years shall be as follows:

The election of the office bearers and members of the Council under this clause shall be carried out in accordance with the Bye-laws of the Institute for the time being in force with regard thereto.

- i) The President and Vice-President shall be FELLOWS and the Hony Secretary, Hony Joint Secretary and Hony Treasurer shall either be FELLOWS or MEMBERS of the Institute and shall be elected by ballot by the FELLOWS and MEMBERS.
- **ii)** Five members of the Council shall be FELLOWS of the Institute and shall be elected by ballot by the FELLOWS.
- iii) Four members of the Council shall be MEMBERS elected by ballot by the MEMBERS.
- iv) Three members of the Council shall be ASSOCIATE MEMBERS elected by ballot by the ASSOCIATE MEMBERS.
- v) While seeking election to the Council, <u>members of any category shall not nominate himself / herself nor consent for more than one position.</u>
- vi) Any vacancy in the Council arising out of resignation, death of the Council member may be filled up by the person / securing the maximum number of votes in the election among the unsuccessful candidates of the same category, in case of unanimous election the Council shall co-opt one member.

13. TENURE OF OFFICE OF THE COUNCIL

- i) The PRESIDENT shall be elected every two years and shall not be eligible for re-election.
- ii) The VICE-PRESIDENT, HONY SECRETARY, HONY JOINT SECRETARY and HONY TREASURER shall be elected every two years and shall be eligible for re-election at the end of their first term of office but shall not be eligible for further re-election until after an interval of at least four years. They shall, however, be eligible for office other than held by them.

The members of the Council shall be elected every two years and shall not be eligible for re-election for more than two consecutive terms but may seek election after the gap of a term.
